

Grandfather Rules:

Definitions:

- It is the skip that secures a position on a league. By definition, a team consists of any group of individuals that is playing with a designated skip. The make up of the team is at the sole discretion of the skip.
- The skip may play any position on the team but the team must be registered in the skip's name.

The following criteria must be met to Grandfather into an existing league:

- A skip may secure a spot on a league that he/she played and skipped on the previous year and has the first right of refusal to join the league.
- A skip secures the spot on the league. Should the skip, for any reason, not register the league the spot is considered "open" and subject to the rules herein.
- The skip must have registered the team by August 1st. If the team is not registered by August 1st the position is considered open.
- The skip had to have been active in the league the entire previous season. A skip does not lose his/her grandfather eligibility if they did not play a portion of the season due to a family crisis or for physical reasons i.e. injury, pregnancy, or illness. Periodic absence due to work or family does not constitute leaving the league. The skip becomes ineligible if he/she withdrew from the league because they choose not to play.

The following preferences will be given to teams desiring admission into a league. Individuals can register as a skip and will be allowed into openings on a league in the following order:

- Individual who have registered as a skip the previous year, registering as a skip.
- Any member of a team whose makeup consists of 3 active players, playing the previous year in the league and whose skip is not returning to the league.
- Individuals who have registered as a skip on the league previous years and have been on the waiting list the highest number of years.
- Any skips on the league the previous year but who left the league by their own choosing, or who did not register as a skip prior to August 1st
- Skips who were in a different league (league 1) the previous year but wish to register in league 2 and where their departure from league 1 will create an opening. Any of the players on the team losing their position in league 2 because a non-returning skip created an opening, have the first right of refusal to register as a skip in the opening created in league 1. If two or more teammates desire to register as a skip the decision will be left to a coin toss.
- Any member of the team whose makeup consists of 2 active players, playing the previous year in the league but whose skip is not returning.
- Any single member of a team playing the previous year in the league but whose skip is not returning.
- New teams made up of a skip that was a member of the CCC the previous year.
- New teams where the skip was not a member of the CCC the previous year.
